Planning Board Minutes Oct. 8, 2024
Regular Meeting

The regular Oct. meeting of the Chaumont Village Planning Board was conducted in person Oct. 8, 2024. This meeting was called to order by Chairman Stumpf at 6:45 pm, in the Town of Lyme office building. Board members in attendance, Bryan Stumpf, Mark Morina, Jennifer Sosa, Nolan Pitkin, Rob Stevenson and Village Board Liaison Doriann Froelich.

Old Business

- Mins approved - Mark made a motion and Nolan seconded it all in fav
- There was a proposal for a crosswalk across Memorial Park — either between Williams residence and Wise Guys, or between Watertown Savings Bank and Wise Guys. The VPB would actually be giving unanimous approval to recommend it to the VBT would then recommend the change to NYDOT, Mark seconded, unanimous ayes, in favor.
- the continue discussion of safety zones on side streets to help prevent injury and blind spots, putting no stopping/standing signs in the safety zones in place
- there was a discussion of suggestion of parking spaces on the main street to help the destruction of view coming off side streets, this will be suggested to the Village Board
- Trash discussion was looked at again to suggest either up to 7 normal kitchen size trash bags or 2 to 3 trash cans for residents, and 8 to 10 bags for businesses - Rob makes motion Nolan seconds it all approved

New Business

- The Planning Board advise to talking to businesses that are affected by the new safety zone locations will be talked to by a Planning Board member before a finalization has been made, to discuss changes to get their input so that we are all on the same page with these changes
